

URGE CONGRESS TO ACT NOW ON COVID RELIEF PACKAGE

Efforts for a COVID relief package before the holidays are edging closer. Negotiations continue as the House and Senate leadership meet to finalize details and broker contentious provisions. In lieu of a deal this week, Congress is expected to pass a short-term continuing

resolution to extend the funding for the government over the weekend. The over \$1 Trillion package is expected to include several important provisions our industry has advocated for

namely a second round of Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) loans, which have been a lifeline to so many small businesses.

In the meantime, this is your last chance to act to demand meaningful economic relief in 2020. Act now before it's too late!

SAFEST OUTSIDE: EXTENSION OF PREMISES

The State of Arizona created the Safest Outside Restaurant Assistance Program, which is designed to assist bars and restaurants with funding for the infrastructure needed to expand their premises. With \$1 million total in the fund, businesses may apply for up to \$10,000 to cover expenditures for items restaurants need to extend their premises, such as outdoor furniture, barriers, patio heaters, or parklets.
